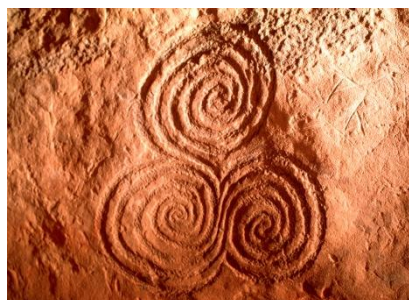

IELTS Full-time Exam Strategy Full-time Day Programme

The International English Language Testing System (IELTS) is an internationally recognised qualification and entry requirement for universities in the UK, Ireland, Australia and New Zealand. This programme will prepare you for the IELTS Exam to ensure you get the grade you need.

A good IELTS score will help you in your further studies, particularly if you want to study at a university in one of the previously mentioned countries. It is also widely used by governments as a language proficiency guide when issuing work visas and is accepted by various professional organisations.
